Rules for Making Exhibits

1. All exhibits must be made in the classroom of any **public, private or home school** within the county.
2. Enter exhibits at the fairgrounds 4-H building on Tuesday from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.
3. Entries may be submitted by the classroom teacher only (no students).
4. The number of the entry, the name of the student, or students who made the exhibits, the grade, the school and teacher's name must be listed on the back of entry or on each separate article in a project or collection.
5. Class may enter 2 exhibits under the same premium number.
6. Teachers are urged to select the proper classification for each entry.
- 7 Any exhibit not conforming to the following instructions will not be judged.

A. An individual entry is one paper 9x12 inches mounted on posterboard 11x14 unframed.

B. A poster should not exceed 22x28 inches. Subject for a poster include: health, patriotism, economics, energy, communication.

C. A project is defined as one article or group of articles pertaining to a specific subject premium. This may include work from only one class.

D. A collection is made up of 3 or 4 articles. Entries will be judged on quality (50 points) and original student work (50 points).

8. The decision of the judges is final.
